WHAT IS A BIBLE VERSE, AND A REFERENCE?

HERE'S THE ANSWER!

The Bible is one big book, made up of 66 smaller books. People organized most of the 66 books into chapters. Each chapter is made up of many verses.

A Bible reference is like an address. It helps us find a specific verse in the Bible.

In a Bible reference, the name of the book comes first, then the number of the chapter, then the number of the verse.

So, to find the verse Romans 3:23 in our Bibles we would go to the book of Romans, chapter 3, and then find verse 23.

The chapter numbers are the biggest numbers on the pages, and the verse numbers are the smaller numbers.

You can find the names of the books at the top of each page in the Bible. Or, for a list of all 66 books, and the page numbers where each book starts, you can go to the Table of Contents at the beginning of the Bible.

If you have a Bible, see if you can find some of the verses in this list to learn more about God, and the Lord Jesus Christ.
